






Introduction

- 1. HEARD (Health of Ethiopian Animals for Rural Development) Livestock Value Chain Public Private Dialogue - 15 M€ programme up to 2024 - Covering Oromia, Tigray and Afar, Amhara and Somalia
- The programme aims to enhance the Rationalisation of Animal Health Service Delivery System through implementing three outcomes:
 - 1) The quality of public and private veterinary services strengthened and delivery optimised;
 - 2) Technical competences and incentives for veterinary service providers improved; and
 - 3) Capacity built for food safety of primary products of animal origin and for control of zoonotic diseases.
- Federal and regional government are the partners on Government side and EVA with ILRI on the private sector side


















Link to the overall development framework

- The programme being specific to veterinary service; Gov has to create the synergy with other programme having livestock as a component such as the pastoral strategy




