Outcomes:

Coordination should solve real problems

Example is the expansion of Shek Ali Gur Gully that threaten Jigjiga City

- Geology, topography, soil condition accelerates the risk of gully formation in the area
- Deforestation in upper catchment, quarries, road development, urban run-off caused the gully to expand rapidly
- In 7-8 years it will affect the urban area of Jigjiga
- It is already affecting water supply
- There is some success with WSWs but problem need to be addressed at least at catchment scale with range of interventions and regulations
- Added to this is uncontrolled waste disposal

Stakeholders should cooperate in regional area planning framework to address the issue
