



Outcomes:

How the finance and budgeting system is organized has a large influence on development

- Limited budgets: only cater for staff costs and basic expenses, very small internally generated budgets
- Procedural aspects: requests submitted when there is much competition to time, actual allocations often delayed leaving little time for implementation, in some cases time-consuming procurement, no multi-annual budgets
- Limited capacity: understaffing, staff turnover, lack of basic equipment
- Remove procedural bottlenecks through better timing of budgeting process
- Build on current 10 year Prosperity Plans to have more detailed future prioritization
- Revisit reporting system: more user friendly and less geared to only justification to higher level
- Budget monitoring to prevent over- or underspending, updated price schedules
- Procurement training and coaching for Woreda staff
- Supporting contractors in implementing contracts
